Eligibility : You can participate if you are studying in a university/college in Taiwan (including foreign students, graduated students, apply as individual or group-at most 5 people).

Submission Deadline : before 23:59 Sunday, November 5th 2023

Objective :

The aim of the competition is to develop students' understanding of global citizenship and to turn their ideas into reality. We support college students to develop action projects that help to achieve the United Nations' Global Goals.

Theme of this year :

Goal 5 Gender Equality

Submission Format :

1. You can submit work of any size : Digital designs should be submitted as PDF. If submitting a traditional painting or drawing, it should be scanned and sent as PDF.
2. **All posters must be original art. No trademarked or copyrighted images or phrases should be used.**
3. Design mode: can be portrait/straight or landscape/horizontal; One to Four panel comic template (At most 4 panel templates) ; Design principles Examples, please check last page (P.3) °
4. All design entries must include phrases in English, if you fail to do so, you will be disqualified from the contest.
5. Must have design title for the entry; The entry title could be in Chinese or English °

Winning Criteria :

The best design will be selected by a panel of PU judges and announced by December 9th 2022. The list of winners will be displayed on the official website.

Each work will be evaluated based on the following Criteria:

3. Entries that do not meet these requirements will be deleted from the contest.
4. We do not allow designers to submit the same design to multiple contests, because this can create legal problems regarding copyright.
5. You will be notified by email when you win a contest. Please make sure that emails from @gm.pu.edu.tw will not go directly to your spam or trash folder. Next, you will need to provide the copy of ID/ARC and Post Office Account.

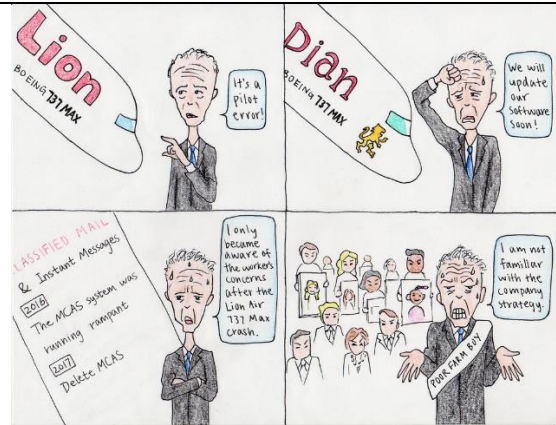
